


Corona Update, IJsselstein 16 March 2020



Corona regulations in The Netherlands

At this moment additional regulations in The Netherlands have come into effect to reduce the spreading of the virus. This means that all schools, day-care centers, restaurant and bars are closed, and that a lot of Dutch people work from home.

ABS follows all rules and regulations which are set by the national health authorities and the Dutch government.

ABS organisation

The ABS office and warehouse are open for business. At ABS we take all the necessary precautions to ensure a safe work environment. A large portion of our team works from home and communicates via e-mail and phone with customers and colleagues.

Apart from colleagues working from home instead of the office, it is business as usual at this moment. The in- and outbound flow of goods is under control and orders are shipped on time.
